CUHK Chung Chi College x HSBC Young Leaders Award 2025/2026 Information Sheet

"Young Leaders Award" supported by The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited (HSBC) would be launched in academic year 2025/2026 to attract, identify and develop all-rounded students and promote the "Chung Chi Spirits" focusing on Excellence in Academics and Sports (文武雙全), Cultivation of Virtue and Talents (德才兼備) and Enhancement of Spirituality (靈性修為). The awards are renewable given the student can fulfill the renewal requirements of the assigned tasks of the programme.

Monetary rewards

- 10 awards of HK\$50,000 each in academic year 2025/2026
- The awards are renewable for maximum two years given the students can fulfill the renewal requirements of the programme including but not limited to attaining Year GPA of 3.00 or above in the previous academic year. They are required to demonstrate satisfying performance in the programme activities such as mentorship/job shadowing programme, internship programme, C-Suite Dialogue Series, community work, mental wellbeing, and progress in academic, sports, arts and cultural achievements etc.

Non-monetary rewards

- Organize fire side chat with C-suite leader as part of the C-Suite Dialogue Series
- Pair with a senior executive in the industry who will serve as a career and programme mentor
- Structured project-based opportunities designed to foster professional and personal development programme

Eligibility

To be eligible, the candidates must:

- be the students of Chung Chi College admitted in the academic year 2025/2026;
- select Chung Chi College as their first college preference after they are admitted into The Chinese University of Hong Kong;
- demonstrate outstanding performance in public examinations and extracurricular activities such as having track record in the fields of language and publications, innovation and research, and sport achievement; showing outstanding contributions and commitment to voluntary and community services; showing spirituality enhancement in terms of mental wellbeing, creativity in arts and culture etc.
- applicants with financial needs will be given higher priority when performance at other criteria are similar.

- 2. Completed application form together with all requisite documents should be submitted online on or before 12:00pm, 12 Aug 2025. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

- 4. The decisions of the college and the corporate sponsor are final and not subject to review, and the reasons for nominating, shortlisting, granting or refusing to offer an award will not be given.
